## It All Adds Up

In the first quarter of this year 75 volunteers spent 528 hours, made 3,321 inmate visits and were blessed to be present during the salvation of 49 souls during their time in local jails and detention centers.

From July 2016 to December 2016 the Ministry distributed to inmates:

- 565 Bibles
- 2,452 faith based books
- 1,655 mini faith based books from RBC Ministries, KCM Ministries
- 4,763 faith based magazines like Daily Bread, Guideposts, Decision, Victory
- 1,772 Bible studies from ECS Ministries (a 14 book certificate course)  
... all handed out by our dedicated volunteers.

That is an average of

- 94 Bibles
- 409 faith based books
- 276 mini faith based books
- 795 faith based magazines
- 295 Bible studies      ... **each month**

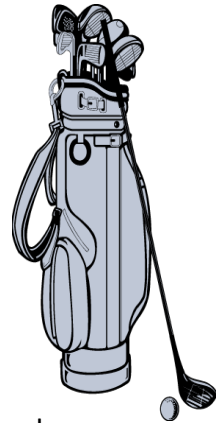
